Elective Class Description

ADVANCED ART

If you are serious about art, this class is for you! Being creative is part of our identity in being “wonderfully & fearfully made” by our Creator. We will work with a variety of mediums, including pencil, pastel, acrylic, watercolor, and collage. **(\$15 materials fee required)**

BEADING

Come learn how to create your own jewelry! Students will create a variety of pieces and learn basic techniques for assembling jewelry, wire wrapping, beading on a loom, carving soapstone, and macramé' are all options. All levels of experience are welcome. **(\$5.00 material fee)**

CHESS

Come and learn to play chess in a competitive setting. Students will play tournaments. Groups will change weekly based on player's ability.

COOKING

Come join Basic Cooking and we will have a fun time learning to bake, chop, boil and measure a variety of yummy food and treats! You will learn about food preparation and there will be lots of sampling from your culinary creations. **(\$20 materials fee required)**

CREATIVE CARDS & CRAFTS

Do you want to learn how to make your own cards? Do you like to be creative? Do you love to work with paper and art supplies? Then this class is for you! **(\$10 materials fee is required)**

DRAMA

Lights! Camera! Action! Come join the world of drama. We will learn about theatre arts; preparing for and performing a play for the student body and parents for the Elective Celebration on March 1. (Addition costs for costumes/props may be required)

KIDS ON THE MOVE/GYMNASTICS

This class will teach you the basics in tumbling and gymnastics. Have fun tumbling and rolling on mats and balancing on beams.

KNITTING

Come learn how to knit! Practice your skills if you already do. The class will learn basic knitting techniques while working toward a completed project. Supplies will be provided, but any extras from home that you would be willing to share would be appreciated. **(\$10 materials fee)**

LET'S PLAY GAMES

Have fun with your friends playing games like scrabble, battleship, yatzee & more! Build your skills and learn new games too!

LEARNING WITH LEGOS

Have fun building with Legos while you learn about simple machines and structures. We will have team challenges and individual activities that explore how levers, gears, and pulleys work; and we will learn how to create the biggest and strongest buildings and bridges!

READ NATURALLY

Read Naturally is for students who want or need individual encouragement to improve their reading skills. Read Naturally is specially designed to meet each student at their individual reading level and be fun and engaging for the students. This elective can be teacher, parent or student requested. (2nd-4th grade only)

SELF-DEFENSE

Students will learn simple self-defense techniques and drills in a fun atmosphere. The teaching will also focus on developing Christian-like attitude as well as making good choices both at home and school.

SONFLOWERS

Each week we will bloom in faith as we learn more about our God while being creative together. In this all-girl class we will design our own journal and add to it weekly. We will also craft jewelry, accessories and other items. As we do so we will get to know one another and God in a very real way! **(\$10 materials fee required)**

STUDY HALL

Study hall is an opportunity to get assistance and complete your homework during elective time for students who have after school activities.

TEACHER'S AIDE

Mrs. Landers oversees this elective where a limited number of students may be chosen to aide in the following: Kindergarten, 1st Grade, Elective Classes, and CCS Office.
