



Uniform Dress Code Kindergarten – 5th Grade

The uniform dress is required Monday through Thursday.
Every Friday is free dress.

Uniform Colors

Shirts:

- White
- Navy Blue
- Light Blue
- Yellow (pale or standard)

Sweatshirts, Sweaters and Vests:

- Must be CCS or a solid Navy Blue only

Shirt Standards

- No Neon colors
- All shirts/ blouses must be solid in color and collared
- No T-shirts

Bottoms / Dresses: (Pants, shorts, skirts jumpers dresses)

- Tan Khaki
 - Navy Blue
- No denim or jeans or plaid**

Socks

- Must be a solid uniform color (white, navy blue, tan/Khaki)
- Can be no higher than the knee

Outerwear:

- **Jackets:** Rain and ski jackets can be any color or pattern but must be removed before entering the classroom.
- **Sweatshirts, Sweaters and Vests:** Must be CCS or a solid Navy Blue only

Shoes:

- Closed heel & toe
- No high heels or platforms
- No “wheeled” shoes
- No Crocs

**All clothing must be solid in color with no trim, pictures, or wording of any kind other than the Chico Christian School Logo or a small brand logo (no larger than the size of a quarter).
All clothing must fit properly, be in good condition and with no holes or fraying.
Clothing worn under uniform that can be seen must be approved uniform color.**

Uniform Pants/Shorts

- **Must be solid in color (tan khaki or navy blue) with no trim, pictures, words or embellishments (bling).**
- Must fit properly without sagging from the waist or dragging on the ground, and must be in good condition with no holes or fraying.
- Cargo pants/ shorts are permitted. No denim/jeans or plaid will be allowed except for on free dress Fridays.
- Length can be no shorter than half way between the hip and knee for the older students this is about 4 inches above the knee. This rule must be followed even with leggings or tights under shorts.
- Girls may not wear leggings or yoga pants independently. Leggings, yoga pants and tights may only be worn under clothing and may only be white, navy blue or tan khaki.

Uniform Dresses/Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers

- Skirts and jumpers are to be solid navy or tan-khaki only and must be modest in length
- No denim/jeans or plaid will be allowed except for on free dress Fridays.

- Polo dresses, either long or short sleeves, may be navy blue, white, yellow, light blue or tan-khaki.
- Length should be no shorter than half way between the hip and the knee. For older students this is about 4 inches from the knee.
- Girls must wear shorts, tights or leggings under dresses, skirts and jumpers.
- Tights, leggings or shorts or yoga pants may only be worn under clothing and may only be uniform colors of navy or tan khaki.

Uniform Shirts/ Sweatshirts:

- Polo shirts/blouses must be collared and solid colored in white, navy, light blue or yellow. They can be long or short sleeved.
- Any branding logos other than the Chico Christian logo must be smaller than a quarter.
- Layering with turtleneck, crew-necks, and tank tops under a polo is permitted as long as all layers conform to color requirements for dress code tops: navy blue, light blue, white or yellow.
- Sweaters and sweatshirts must be solid navy blue or CCS sweatshirts.
- T-shirts are not allowed to be worn Monday-Thursday (these include: I heart CCS shirts, CCS athletic shirts, CCS lion run shirts, etc.)
- Field trip shirts may only be worn on field trip days.

Outerwear:

Jackets: Rain and ski jackets may be any color or pattern. They are only allowed to be worn outside and will be required to be taken off when entering the classroom.

Sweatshirts: All sweatshirts, sweaters, and vests must be solid navy blue or a CCS sweatshirt. A small logo no larger than a quarter is allowed on the front.

Field Trips:

- CCS will provide a standard field trip shirt to each student at the beginning of the school year.
- Field trip shirts may not be worn as dresses and must be worn with shorts, pants, or skirts.
- Extra shirts are available for purchase at a cost of \$15 each in the CCS office.
- Students who have forgotten their field trip shirt will be issued a dress code violation and will be given a shirt so they can participate in the field trip. They will be given one penalty free violation. After the first violation, the parent will be charged \$5 for the use of the field trip shirt. The borrowed field trip shirt must be turned in within 7 days to avoid being charged an additional \$5. **(See dress code contract in first day of school folders for more information on this)**

Free Dress Days/Theme Days

Every Friday is free dress or a theme day. The student council will designate the theme. A student may choose to participate in the theme or not. If they choose not to participate in the theme, it will be free dress day. Free dress must still conform to the following dress code:

- Free dress is ONLY to be worn on Fridays. If we have no school on Friday, Thursday will NOT be a free dress day.
- No sweat pants (knit or fleece)
- No yoga pants, or leggings unless worn with a top that falls halfway between the hip and the knee.
- Spandex shorts may be worn by girls under dresses, skirts and jumpers only.
- Shorts/skirts/skort/dresses must be hemmed and modest in length. Length can be no shorter than halfway between the hip and knee. For older students this is about 4 inches above the knee.
- No shirt or dress with less than a 2" strap.
- No inappropriate wording or pictures on clothing especially foul language. Clothing must not advertise alcoholic products, drugs, weapons, skulls or cross bones, or inappropriate symbols.

Additional daily standards:

Girls:

- Makeup is not allowed. Fingernail polish is acceptable, but please avoid dark colors.
- Excessively tight fitting or baggy clothing is not allowed.
- No dangling or hoop earrings. Other modest jewelry is acceptable, as long as it is not distracting to other students. Students should be aware that they are responsible for any loss of or damage to jewelry worn at school.
- No unnatural hair colors.
- No hats are to be worn in the classroom.

Boys:

- No hats are to be worn in the classroom.
- Hair must be kept neatly groomed and out of eyes.
- No unnatural hair colors.
- No earrings allowed

Violations:

The first two weeks of the school year are considered a grace period. Parents will be notified of violations during this time. Any violations aft this grace period will result in the following. **(See dress code contract in first day of school folders for more information on this)**

- Students will be allowed one violation per year without penalty.
- The parent will be notified in writing of the violation and will receive a phone call, email or face to face contact informing them of the specific violation to ensure it will not happen again.
- After the first violation, alternate clothing will be loaned to the student. The parent will be contacted and will be responsible to pay a five-dollar fee.
- If alternate clothing is available student will be loaned a change of clothing. Loan clothing must be returned to the office within seven days. If loan clothing is not returned within 7 days the parent will be contacted and required to pay a late fee of \$5 for every week the clothing item is missing.
- If no alternate clothing is available, the parent will be contacted to bring a change of clothes but still.
