ALL ABOUT ART

No one can create like you! Explore the wonderful world of ART using your amazing eyes, hands and your unique, one-of-a-kind talent! Being creative is part of our identity in being “wonderfully & fearfully made”. We will be exposed to a variety of mediums, including pencil, pastel, acrylic, watercolor, collage, and clay. Yeah ART! **(\$10 materials fee required)**

CERAMICS

God gives us all a talent. Come be creative using your hands in clay. We will make lots of fun things out of clay that you will keep forever or give as gifts. **(\$10 materials fee required).**

CHESS

Play chess in a competitive setting. Play tournaments. Groups will change weekly based on ability of player.

COMPETITIVE SPORTS TEAMS

We are having a flag football team for 5-6 grades and 7-8 grades. We will be practicing during electives and the games will take place after school. The program is through CARD where we will be playing all the other public and private schools in our community. **Sign ups have already taken place. DRAMA

The Drama Elective is an excellent way to “Act Up and Act Out”! In this elective we will learn about theatre arts; preparing for and performing a wonderful play for the student body and parents at the Elective Celebration. This is an exciting way for students to gain greater confidence, increasing their public performance and speaking skills. FRENCH

Discover French language and culture through meaningful classroom activities that parallel everyday life situations. You will become motivated to communicate in French because lessons are authentic, drawn from language used in real life situations. We will also discover the beauty of France and French cuisine and learn some typical French cultural practices. We will begin practicing French out loud, speaking to each other in the new language, beginning on the first day.

SELF-DEFENSE

Students will learn simple self-defense techniques and drills in a fun atmosphere. The teaching will also focus on developing a Christ-

like attitude as well as making good choices both at home and at school.

SPANISH

Begin to learn the Spanish language through a discovery of Latin cultures, people, and food. This class will focus on conversational Spanish through an interactive teaching style and the inclusion of a number of different mediums to learn vocabulary, key cultural concepts, and listening comprehension.

STUDY HALL

Study hall is an opportunity to get assistance and complete your homework during elective time.
